

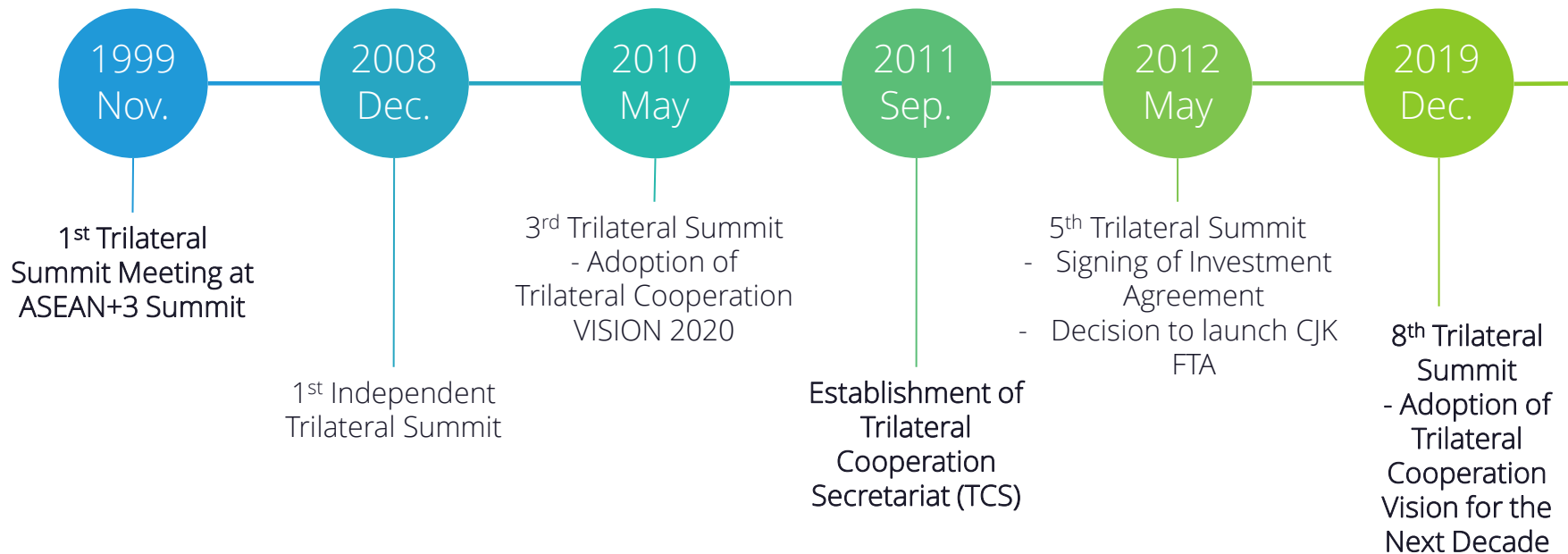

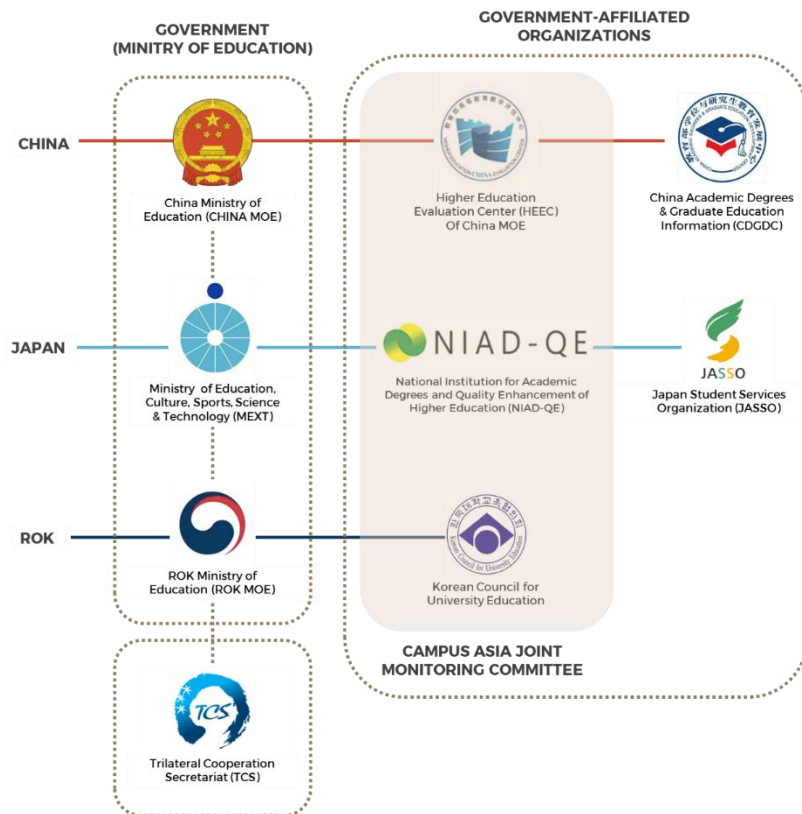

# CAMPUS Asia Program

## OVERVIEW

- Collective Action for Mobility Program of University Students in Asia
- Initiative of **Ministries of Education** of China and the ROK, and **Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology** of Japan
- Student exchange program among the universities of the three countries to promote exchange and cooperation among universities
- Started as a pilot program in 2011; Developed into full-fledged program from September 2016 (with 17 consortia with 39 universities CJK)
- Updated in November 2021 (with 20 consortia including 65 CJK & ASEAN universities)

# Asia International Youth Film Festival (AIYFF)

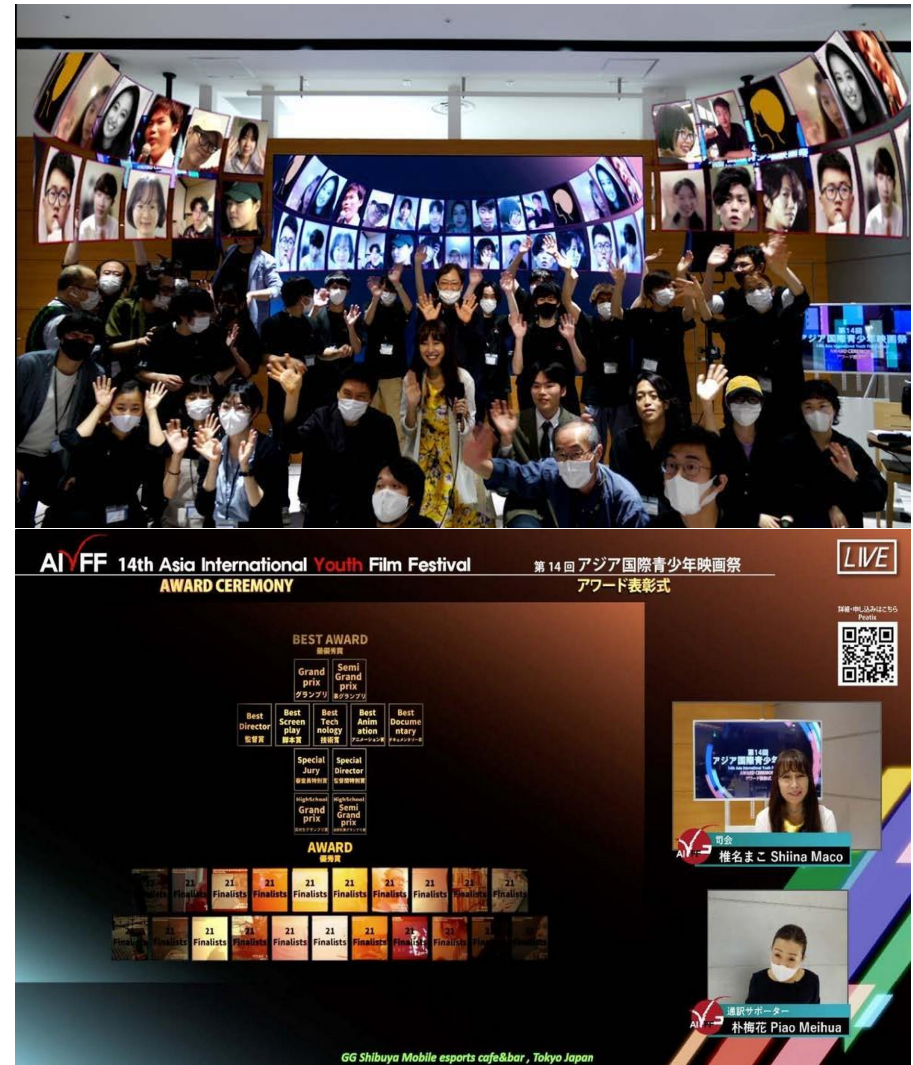
## PURPOSE

- To promote exchange of visual culture between CJK youth by the platform for up-and-coming directors since 2004

## 2021 PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- **Duration:** May 3 to June 20, 2021
- **Place:** Tokyo, Japan & Online
- **Participants:** 21 finalists selected from several hundred films submitted from the three countries
- **14th AIYFF Program:**
  - Film contest with theme “Symbiosis” (共生, 공생)
  - Special lectures
  - Awards ceremony

## PURPOSE

- **Place:** Shenzhen – Tokyo – Seoul
- **Participants:** 12 journalists from the 3 countries

- **Theme:** New Changes and New Trends in CJK Media
- **Time:** June 21, 2021
- **Place:** Seoul & Online
- **Participants:** 9 journalists from the 3 countries

## PURPOSE

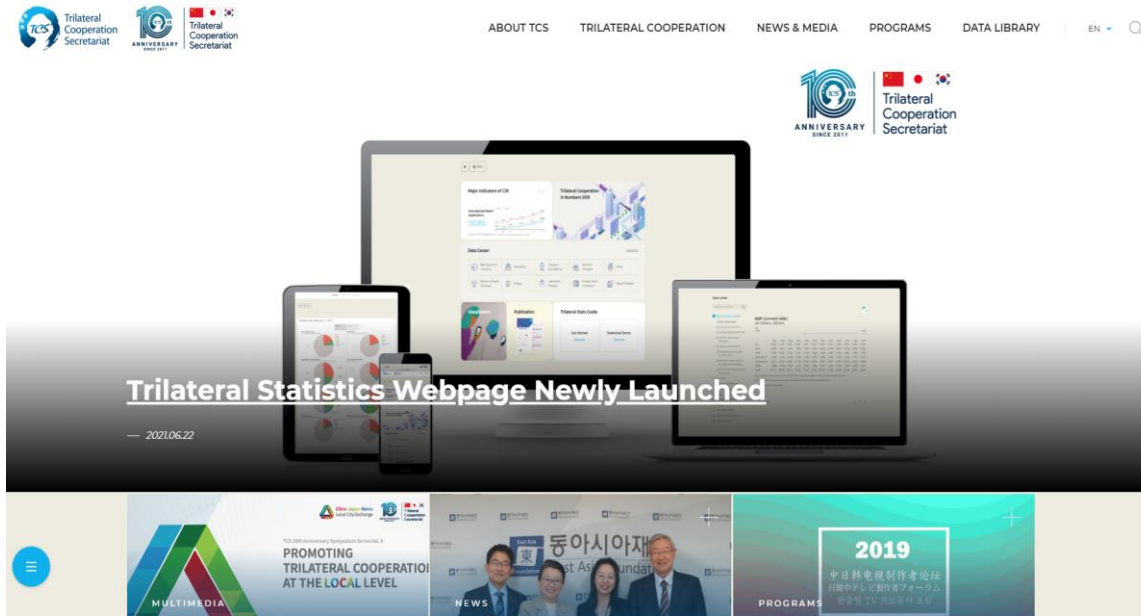
- To deepen mutual understanding and facilitate smooth communication among the three countries
- To promote exchanges and research among the experts on Chinese characters and linguistics

## OVERVIEW

- Trilateral Common Vocabulary Dictionary Editorial Committee consisting of 16 experts from the three countries
- Incorporates 658 common lexicons with high frequency usage
- 3<sup>rd</sup> edition published in 2020
